Subject: Economics (Practical Living)

Major Content: Producer

Lesson length: 1 hour

Use the cafeteria as a connection with teaching supply and demand. Class discussion prior to creating their choice of a good or service.

Students devise a plan at home with an adult to produce a good or service they would want to provide with their class.
